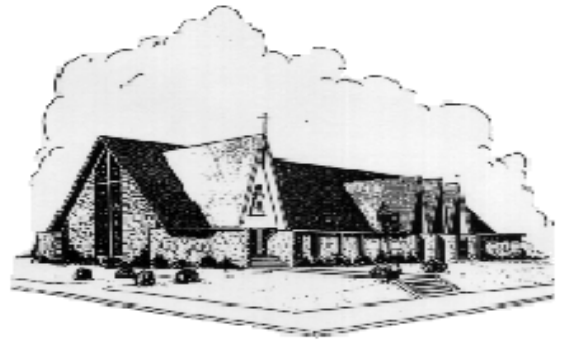

Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

On January 17th, Cardinal Rigali acknowledged Papal Honors bestowed to 17 priests of our Archdiocese, including Father Anthony D'Angelico, Pastor of Our Lady of Good Counsel Church in Southampton, Father Joseph Gentili, Pastor of Our Lady of Guadalupe Church in Buckingham, Father Charles Hagan, Pastor of Our Lady of Mount Carmel Church in Doylestown, and Father Michael Picard, Pastor of St. Andrew Church in Newtown. Reception of these honors confer the title "Monsignor" on these priests. Father Picard has been named a Prelate of Honor, while the others have been named Chaplains of His Holiness.

The title "Monsignor" comes from the French "monseigneur", meaning "My Lord". This title of honor is accorded to all archbishops and bishops (although in the United States it is not used by these prelates), by Protonotaries Apostolic, Honorary Prelates of His Holiness and by Chaplains to His Holiness. In conversation these men are addressed "Monsignor"; and in writing, their names would be preceded by "Rev. Msgr."

Titles and the honors themselves are derived from the days of the temporal powers of the Holy See in the former Papal States. In ancient times, the clerics honored by the papacy were officials of the Court.

In 1969, Pope Paul VI dismantled the Papal Court, along with its honor system, and replaced it with a simplified structure of honors for clergy and laity that reflected his personal discomfort with pageantry and his desire to reshape the entire Church in a more pastoral mode.

Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation: The *Rite of Reconciliation* is celebrated on Saturdays at 9:30 am and 4:00 pm, and by appointment.

Sacrament of Marriage Couples are encouraged to contact the Parish Office soon after their engagement to meet with one of the Parish Priests. The Archdiocese of Philadelphia requires that couples make arrangements for the Wedding no less than six months prior to the planned date of marriage. 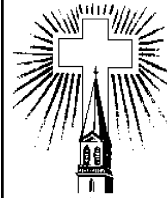

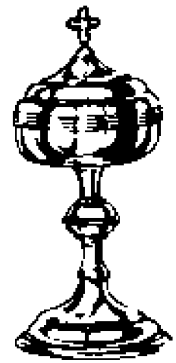
